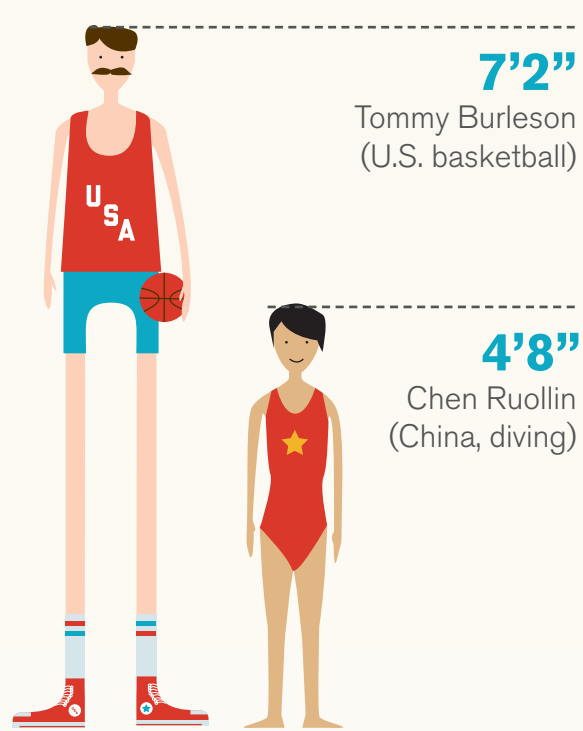

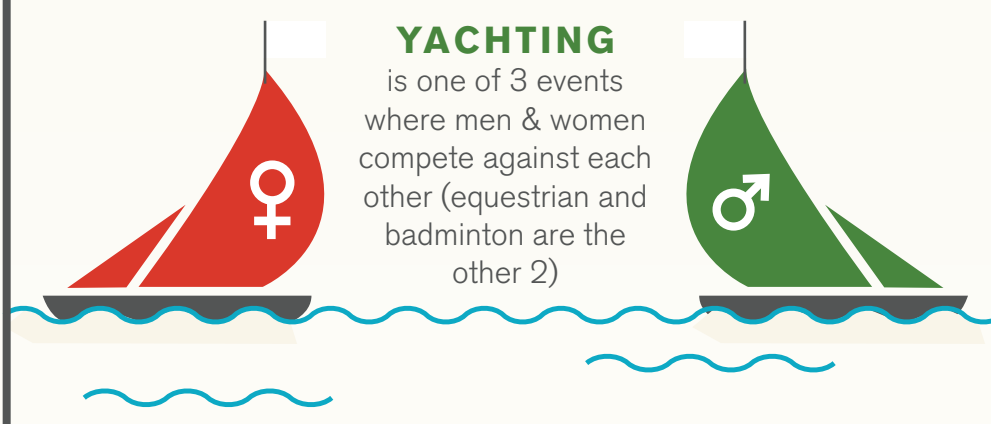

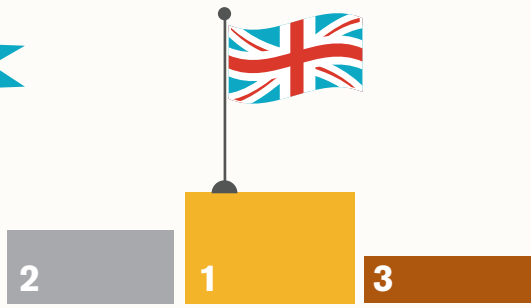
12 athletes have won medals representing 2 different countries

COUNTRY FACTS

In 1936 13-year-old American Marjorie Gestring won the gold medal in springboard diving. She's still the youngest female individual gold medalist.

The best all-time performing basketball athlete at the Olympic Games is US female player Teresa Edwards who won 4 gold medals between 1984 and 2000.

Tied TWICE! Men's swimmers, Anthony Ervin and Gary Hall Jr. finished in a dead heat to win Gold in the 50m freestyle at the 2000 Sydney Olympics. It also happened in 1984 for the women's 100m freestyle for Nancy Hogshead and Carrie Steinseifer who also shared gold.
